I'm sure our supporters and donors are now feeling as disappointed as the DAMES are that our Syrian refugee family is not yet in Canada.

However we are all still optimistic that our 'family' will be here this year as some progress has been made.

This included the required government health checks for all family members. We can report that the family is

in good health so no obstacles there.

The next steps are to obtain their Visas for Canada and arrange travel through the approved process.

We continue to follow up with Immigration Canada and their Saudi Arabia
Office to try and expedite this process.

DAMES FOCUS...

The DAMES met with representatives from the Thorncliffe Neighbourhood Office (TNO) who provided an outline of the excellent services and support they provide for refugees that we can leverage.

We have identified a three (3) bedroom apartment and in process of leasing. We also have a good inventory of furnishings and household items.

A draft budget and 'contract' outlining financial and other support for the family once they arrive was developed.
